## Chapter 847

### OBSCENITY

847.001 Definitions.—As used in this chapter, the term

21. With regard to all sex education or sex related content in public schools used in any subject matter or course, parents shall be notified by their school district or public school ten instructional days in advance of the instruction and must opt their student in to the instruction either in writing or by electronic means. No student shall be exposed to the material without the specific permission of his or her parents. No student shall be penalized if the parents do not grant their permission for the instruction. Teachers who violate this requirement shall be reprimanded with an incident report to their personnel file. Teachers with 3 or more incidents in any school year are subject to dismissal.
